Please note that TRTFN asks hunters **to not harvest moose** east of Atlin Lake to Teslin Lake, **nor caribou, sheep and grizzly bears** anywhere in our Territory, due to low populations and/or their cultural significance. We also request that you **harvest only males**, for whichever species you pursue. Please do not go for 'trophies'. Minimize waste by using every part of the animal. Consider sharing your harvest with others, especially TRT members and Elders. **Respect** the animals with whom we share our land. NOTE: Permission to hunt must be requested every year and previous permission does not guarantee success in future applications.
