Role Overview

This role will be based a minimum of 50% in Atlin, British Columbia, and 50% at the Vancouver head office. Priority will be given to candidates who can spend 100% of their time in Atlin and are citizens of Taku River Tlingit First Nation (TRT). The primary focus is building and maintaining trusted relationships with TRT citizens while supporting the Company's external communications across LinkedIn, Facebook, and Instagram. This is a full-time, salaried position offering comprehensive benefits and company-provided staff housing during rotations in Atlin.

Key Responsibilities
