Field Assistant - 2026 Exploration Program

Location: Based in Atlin

Pay: \$300 per field day

Timing: Late August to mid-September

Role Overview

Xplorer Minerals is hiring up to two field assistants from the local community for a rock sampling program at our Moly-Taku project south of Atlin. You will work alongside our experienced field crew, helping collect, bag and label samples, recording locations by GPS, and carrying gear through the day. The crew flies out by helicopter each morning and returns each evening. There is no camping.

The Details

- **Pay:** \$300 per field day
- **Length:** Roughly 10 to 14 working days, weather dependent, with the possibility of more work in September at our Paddy Pass project near Bennett Lake, depending on how that phase is set up.
- **The position will begin with a couple of days to make sure it is a good fit on both sides.**

What It Takes

- Good physical condition. Full days are spent on foot over steep, rough ground with minimal breaks, moving through brush and over deadfall. You must also be comfortable flying in a helicopter.
- Experience with sampling or field work is preferred but not required. We can train the right person. If you hunt, hike or spend time on the land, you will likely do well.
- Sturdy hiking boots, a rain jacket and warm layers. If you do not have the gear, we will provide it.
